

FINANCIAL TRANSPARENCY: At the St. Cloud Intergroup, nearly 90% of the funds we receive support 12th Step work directly, with the remaining 10% dedicated to making that work possible. For the current year (2026), SCI is projected to receive approximately \$3,500 in group contributions, while expenses will total about \$3,150. The surplus is added to our prudent reserve. SCI only excepts contributions from A.A. groups or individuals in the A.A. program.
