It is our assurance to you that your contributions are going to what we have collectively committed to do. It is confirmation of our “say to do ratio.” It is an annual inventory to make sure we are on track. Afterall, as the Big Book tells us on page 64, “A business which takes no regular inventory usually goes broke.” Taking a commercial inventory is a fact-finding and a fact-facing process.”



12TH STEP OPPORTUNITIES: “As often heard from our past SCI Chair, Alan S., “There’s plenty of 12th Step work to go around.” This remark hits the spot from the perspective of our SCI volunteers. Currently, we have a speaking or meeting engagement nearly every night of any given month. Sometimes we have more than one. Recently, treatment center staff, where we provide speakers quarterly, asked if we could provide speakers monthly. And another treatment facility asked if we could do an AA Public Information talk to their guests, six times in CY 2026. We are very thankful and humbled by these 12th Step requests.
