Perhaps bringing a meeting into a treatment center or correctional facility is more your style. Wherever and however, you'd like to practice your 12th Step, the St. Cloud Intergroup has opportunities for you. Currently, SCI brings meetings and speakers to 18 different locations throughout Central MN. Last year nearly 4,000 people heard the life-saving message of Alcoholics Anonymous because of the service rendered by SCI volunteers. In 2025, our phone line volunteers answered over 700 calls from people wanting information about A.A. If you or your group would like to be involved in these efforts, please come to our next Intergroup meeting held on the 2nd Monday of the month at 6pm. Our meetings last one hour and are solely focused on “carrying the message”.
